Cones

Trash will only be collected from our designated locations, marked by a cone. If you leave garbage bags at other locations, it will not be collected -- and will likely end back up in the river. You are welcome to clean-up at any time from 8:00 am – 2:00 pm. **Please note – trash must be at the cones by 2:00 pm.** That is when the City will begin collecting trash. Anything placed after 2:00 pm will not be collected.

Be sure to dress for the work and the rugged terrain along the banks of the river. It can be chilly in the morning and warmer in the afternoon, so bring a light jacket or sweatshirt and wear long pants. Please wear supportive shoes with some tread to avoid slips and falls.
